MONTH LONG INVESTIGATION LEADS TO ARREST OF YORK CITY MAN

York, PA – On Wednesday, April 17, 2019 the York County Drug Task Force and York City Police concluded a one month investigation when they arrested Luis Gamboa, age 40, 18 N. Pine St., York, charging him with drug and gun offenses.

Over the past month Drug Task Force detectives have purchased cocaine from Gamboa at his residence on N. Pine St. During the course of the investigation it was determined that Gamboa was taking a train from Lancaster to New York City and back in order to acquire his cocaine. During the early afternoon hours of April 17, Gamboa was taken into custody in the City of York. Investigators then searched the residence and located approximately 175 grams of cocaine, a stolen handgun and \$2700 cash. Because of past criminal offenses, Gamboa is not permitted to possess a firearm.

Gamboa was charged with Possession with the Intent to Deliver Cocaine, Persons Not to Possess a Firearm and Receiving Stolen Property. Gamboa was taken to York County Prison.

York County District David Sunday again warned drug dealers and those persons who illegally possess firearms that York County law enforcement will continue to pursue persons who distribute illegal and harmful drugs as well as persons who illegally possess firearms. “York County continues to deal with the effects of illegal drugs as well as the violence that illegal firearms bring. We will make every effort possible to fight these activities and protect our citizens.”

Criminal charges, and any discussion thereof, are merely allegations and all defendants are presumed innocent until and unless proven guilty.
