## **Two York City Men Charged with Illegally Possessing Firearms and Narcotics**

**York, PA** – During the morning hours of Thursday, June 18, 2020, a team of police officers executed a search warrant at a second floor apartment at 725 Pennsylvania Ave., in the City of York. Present in the apartment when police arrived were brothers, Joseph Michael Ramos, age 25 and Carlos Ariel Ramos, age 27. Upon searching the residence investigators located 15 grams of fentanyl, two electronic digital scales, a Glock 45 handgun loaded with a 30 round extended magazine, a FNH .57x28 caliber handgun loaded with 20 rounds of armor piercing rounds and soft body armor. Both were charged with Possession with the Intent to Deliver a Controlled Substance, Firearms offenses and Possessions of Instruments of a Crime (for the body armor), all felony offenses.

District Attorney Dave Sunday said, “The arrest of Joseph and Michael Ramos serves as yet another reminder that we continue to work closely with our local, state and federal law enforcement partners to reduce violent crime in our communities. Removing illegal

firearms and narcotics from our community is a common sense step towards achieving this goal.”

The investigation was conducted by investigators from the York City Police Department and York County Drug Task Force. Assisting with the service of the search warrant on June 18, 2020 were the United States Marshall’s Fugitive Task Force, Pennsylvania State Police, agents from the Office of Attorney General, agents from the Pennsylvania Board of Probation and Parole and the York County Sheriff’s Office.
