PRESS RELEASE

On Sunday, July 26, 2020, a member of the District Attorney's Office tested positive for COVID-19. Our colleague is currently recovering under quarantine and we wish our colleague a speedy and healthy recovery.

Upon receiving this news, the District Attorney's Office immediately took all appropriate actions recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) for Critical Infrastructure Workforce. This includes all recommended protocols outlined within the CDC's updated Public Health Guidance for Community-Related Exposure. Our employee is instructed to remain home until approved for a return to this office by a physician. Furthermore, with the assistance of our colleague, we are communicating with all individuals who may have had potential exposure and are at risk as defined by the CDC.

Since the CDC announced the COVID-19 pandemic and established workplace safety guidelines in March of 2020, the District Attorney's Office has taken steps to protect both our employees and the public. These measures included modified work shifts and hours open to the public in order to limit contact between individuals and promote social distancing. We also supply masks and hand sanitizer for employees and visitors to use. Additionally, any employees who feel ill or display any symptoms of COVID-19 are directed to not come to work and seek medical guidance.

The health and well-being of our employees and the general public continues to be a priority as we navigate this challenging and ever-changing environment. To that end, we will continue to follow and support the recommended CDC guidelines. In doing so, we are confident

that we can safely continue to thoroughly and effectively carryout the critical mission of the District Attorney's Office.
